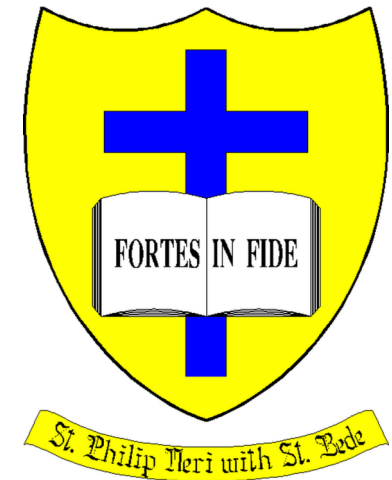

RE

This term, our Come & See topics are:

- Myself, we learn about each other and our importance to God.
- Baptism, a welcome to God's family.
- Birthdays, getting ready for Jesus' birthday.

Maths

The following aspects of mathematics will be covered this term: subitising, counting and number recognition.

Within each unit, children will develop their Fluency, Reasoning and then Problem Solving skills as we endeavour to deepen children's mathematical understanding.

English

The main areas to be covered in English are as follows: speaking and listening skills, retelling events from a story, talking about characters, settings, problems and solutions in stories, telling our own stories.

Understanding the World

Children will learn about people who help us, what happens during autumn and family traditions at Christmas.

Topic

This half term, we take learning about ourselves and our community, we are also looking for signs of autumn.



After Half Term, our topic will be Once Upon a Time and Sparkle and Shine. Within these topics children will learn about traditional tales and

family traditions linked to Christmas.



Phonics

This term, children will learn about hearing letter sounds at the beginning of words, alliteration, oral blending and linking sounds to letters.

PE

PE will be on a Tuesday so your child will need to wear their PE kit to school. Children will be learning gymnastics, parachute games and stop/go games.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term children will be learning about feelings, they will learn to name and talk about their feelings and start to think about how to manage their feelings with adult support.
