The Big Ask Survey

Towards the end of last year, our children took part in the Big Ask survey, which was created by the Children's Commissioner for England, Dame Rachel de Souza. She was keen to hear from young people about the things that make them happy, that worry them and what they would like to see in the future. The results suggest that nationally:

- 84% of children said they were happy or okay with life at school or college;
- 80% of children were happy with their family life;
- 80% of children were happy or okay with their mental health;
- Children care deeply about community;
- Children are pleased to be back in school;
- children care about the environment and the plant.
