RE

This term, our Come & See topics are:

- Good News Sharing the Good News that Jesus has Risen and f the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.
- Friends Learning how to be a good friend like Jesus, we find out that Jesus is our friend too.
- Our World- We think about how we can take care of our world and the creatures we share it with.

Maths

The following aspects of mathematics will be covered this term:

Pentecost 1: To 20 and beyond, First, Then and Now.

Pentecost 2: Find My Pattern, On the Move

Children will be consolidating key skills already learnt this year such as counting, 1:1 correspondence, subitising, comparing and ordering and composition of numbers.

English

This term in English children will be asked to write sentences independently. They will learn to say their sentence out loud and try to remember the words they need to write by repeatedly saying their sentence and using a sound mat to help them to segment and write words.

<u>Understanding the World</u>

Through the topic work children will learn about growing plants, the life cycle of a butterfly, how shadows and reflections are made, the importance of recycling and other ecological ideas. We have some real caterpillars to take care of and observe their transformation into a butterfly.

Topic

This half term, our topics are called Sunshine and Sunflowers and Shadows and Reflections..

Phonics

This term, children will be covering Phase 4 of the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds program, they will continue to work on recognising phonemes, digraphs and trigraphs. Children will develop their skills reading longer words and compound words, they will also look at word endings such as -ing, -ed, -ly. Please continue to practice Tricky words and try to read for a few minutes with your child every day, this really does make a difference!
