<u>French</u>


French will be on Wednesdays. This term will be looking at the topic 'Moi' (All about me).

This term, our Come & See topics are:

<u>Maths</u>

The following aspects of mathematics will be covered this term: identifying objects in the environment, reciting the numbers 1-5 and sorting objects.

<u>English</u>
