Homework

Homework will be given out on a Friday and is to be returned to school on the following Wednesday. Homework will consist of Maths and English, a weekly Spelling List, as well as Reading Journals.

RE

This term, our Come & See topics are:

- Beginnings, focusing on the opportunities new beginnings bring.
- Signs and symbols, looking further into baptism.
- Preparations, as we enter advent and prepare for the birth of Jesus Christ.

We will also spend a week looking at Judasim as part of our other faiths teaching.

Maths

The following aspects of mathematics will be covered this term: place value; addition, and subtraction and money.

Within each unit, children will develop their Fluency, Reasoning and then Problem Solving skills as we endeavour to deepen children's mathematical understanding.

English

In English we will focus on writing for enjoyment using the story of A house that once was; We will write to inform by producing a non-chronological report on the streets of Mansfield in the past. In Grammar will focus on correctly using the past tense accurately, the use of conjunctions to add extra information to a sentence as well as the four different types of sentences. Our punctuation focus will be on using a capital letter for proper nouns (as well as starting a sentence) using a comma between two adjectives and consistently using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces correctly throughout our writing.



Our first unit is all about eSafety- understanding how to stay safe on the internet. We will then move on to look at coding.

Science

In science, children will learn about the lifecycles of different animals. They will gain first hand experience of life cycles through observing butterflies grow from an egg. Our learning will then move on to look at humans and how to keep healthy.

After half term we will learn all about the different uses of materials.

History

This half term, our topic is Street Detectives we will begin by exploring The Mansfield Heritage Trail. Our learning will then take us back to the early 1900's and the differences between now and then.

After Half Term, our topic will be Towers, Tunnels and Turrets. Will will be exploring different human geographical features around the world, why and how they are built.
