RE

This term, our Come & See topics are:

- Homes we will explore how God is present in every home and how this is expressed in the love that binds the family together through good times and bad times;
- Promises we will explore the promises made at Baptism and Congirmation as a call to a new way of life;
- Visitors this topic emphasises the coming of God, in the person of Jesus, 2,000 years ago at Bethlehem.

Maths

The following aspects of mathematics will be covered this term: place value; addition & subtraction, multiplication & division.

Within each unit, children will develop their Fluency, Reasoning and Problem Solving skills as we endeavour to deepen children's mathematical understanding.

English

The main areas to be covered in English are as gollows: a historical narrative, a persuasive letter and instructional writing. Please note that Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar are taught throughout each unit of work.

Science

In science, children will learn about light: what a light source is, how shadows are made, how light replects and staying sage in the sun. After half term, we will move on to studying rocks and how they are formed, in line with our Tremors topic.

Topic

This half term, we will take a journey 'Through the Ages' and learn all about the Store Age, Bronze Age and Iron



Age. We will investigate the societal and environmental changes over this time. This topic has a pocus on the skills of being a Historian.

After Half Term, we become Geographers as we delve into rocks, volcanoes, earthquakes, tsunamis and their impact on humans and the environment. This topic is called 'Tremors'.

Computing

This term, children will learn about Internet Sagety and will develop skills to effectively and sagely search the internet. They will also learn to present data and information using different platforms.
