Attendance

Welcome back to a new term! Firstly, may we formally welcome **Miss Millington** who has been successfully appointed as our **Attendance Officer**, replacing Ms Davidson. She began this role from Monday and I look forward to working with her to maintain our good attendance figures. If you have any attendance queries, please direct these to Miss Millington.

As we start a new half term, please be reminded of our attendance monitoring procedures. Each half term, you will receive one of three 'Traffic Light' letters. A **Green letter** congratulates you on ensuring your child's attendance is above 96%. An Am-

ber letter informs you that attendance is between 93% and 95.9%, which is below the national expectations of 96%. This letter may invite you to meet with Mrs Brizzolara, our Child and Family Support Worker, to discuss how we can support you. A Red letter informs you that your child's attendance is below 92.9% which is very concerning. This letter explains that your child's attendance will be closely monitored and you may be requested to meet Miss Millington for an Attendance Improvement Meeting. Failure to improve attendance could result in a fine being issued by the Local Authority.



Our whole school attendance has been below 96% this week. I do hope this improves next week. To give your child the best possible start in life, good attendance is absolutely essential. Children are much more likely to learn, develop and succeed when they attend school consistently. Please also be reminded that lateness is recorded as an absence. **Pupils must be in school by 8.55am** for the close of the register. To help with this, remember that the school gates are open from 8.35am. Thank you for your support with this.

Admissions

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Please note that from next week (Monday 7th November), **parents wishing for a Reception place from September 2023 will be able to apply**. The application window will be open until the deadline of 15th January. Applications can be made through the <u>Nottinghamshire County Council Admissions Hub</u>. Please also remember to submit a Supplementary Information Form if you wish for a school place to be considered under a faith criterion. Please note that you MUST include the supporting evidence with this form. If you are unable to locate the required faith evidence, please contact the parish where your child was baptised in good time for a 'copy' certificate to be supplied. Please also note that we are now full in all year groups across the school. Unfortunately, admissions for all year groups will not be offered.

Little Acts of Kindness

In case you missed it in our previous Newsletter, the Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Multi-Academy Trust has set up the Little Acts of Kindness Fund to offer financial support for all registered pupils who attending schools in the Trust. This is to help families with the cost of living crisis. The Fund supplements families who need support in paying for:

- Curriculum trips and year group residential (up to 100% of the cost);
- Other educational visits and trips;
- Travel to and from school.

- School uniform, shoes or sports/PE kit;
- School meals;
- Educational equipment.



Please note that all payments are discretionary and if awarded, do not need to be repaid. Pupils may be eligible for grants from the fund if: household income is below £25,000; a pupil whose parents are currently claiming other means-tested benefits including: Income Support, Working Tax Credit/ Child Tax Credit, Income Based Employment and Support Allowance (ESA), Universal Credit – who is not entitled to free school meals; or at the decision of the Headteacher or the Trust's Head of Finance, any pupil who does not fall under the categories listed above, but consider themselves to be in financial hardship.
