### Little Acts of Kindness

In case you missed it in our previous Newsletters, the Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Multi-Academy Trust has set up the *Little Acts of Kindness Fund* to offer financial support for all registered pupils who attending schools in the Trust. This is to help families with the cost of living crisis. The *Fund* supplements families who need support in paying for:



- Curriculum trips and year group residential (up to 100% of the cost);
  - Other educational visits and

trips;

- School uniform, shoes or sports/PE kit;
- School meals;
- Educational equipment.
- Travel to and from school.

Please note that all payments are discretionary and if awarded, do not need to be repaid. Pupils may be eligible for grants from the fund if: household income is below £25,000; a pupil whose parents are currently claiming other means-tested benefits including: Income Support, Working Tax Credit/ Child Tax Credit, Income Based Employment and Support Allowance (ESA), Universal Credit — who is not entitled to free school meals; or at the decision of the Headteacher or the Trust's Head of Finance, any pupil who does not fall under the categories listed above, but consider themselves to be in financial hardship.

# Streptococcus A (Strep A)

I know you'll be aware of the illness Strep A/Scarlet Fever that is all over the media at present. Group A Streptococcus (GAS), also known as Strep A, are bacteria commonly found on the skin or in the throat. Under some circumstances these bacteria can cause disease. Scarlet Fever is usually a mild illness but it is highly infectious. Therefore, please look out for the following symptoms in your child, which include:

- flu-like symptoms, such as a high temperature, swollen glands or an aching body
- sore throat (strep throat or tonsillitis)
- a rash that feels rough, like sandpaper (scarlet fever)
- nausea and vomiting
- scabs and sores (impetigo)
- pain and swelling (cellulitis)

When reporting a child's absence to school, please inform us if they have any of the above symptoms. If you or your child has a high fever, severe muscle aches, pain in one area of the body and unexplained vomiting or diarrhoea seek medical help immediately. The Local Authority released further information about this yesterday which we have shared via Class Dojo and email. We have also shared updated advice from the Trust; please do take the time to read this information carefully.
