Nursery	Emily Harris Foundation	The Emily Harris Foundation provides financial support for King's Mill Hospital Neonatal unit staff members, who wish to undertake further training and where the funding is not able to be supported by the NHS. It also provides financial relief, in cases of hardship, for families with babies receiving care on the King's Mill Hospital Neonatal unit.
FS2KW	Little Princess Trust	The Little Princess Trust provides real hair wigs, free of charge, to children and young people who have lost their own hair through cancer treatment and other conditions.
