## Admissions

For parents wishing for a Reception place from September 2023, <u>now your final opportunity to</u> <u>apply</u>. The application window closes 15th January. Applications can be made through the <u>Nottinghamshire County Council Admissions Hub</u>. Please also remember to submit a Supplementary Information Form if you wish for a school place to be considered under a faith criterion. Please note that you MUST include the supporting evidence with this form. If you are unable to locate the required faith evidence, please contact the parish where your child was baptised in good time for a 'copy' certificate to be supplied. Please also note that we continue to be completely full in all year groups across the school. Unfortunately, admissions for all year groups will not be offered.
