#### Hamewark

Homework continues to be given out on a Friday and is to be returned to school on the following Wednesday. Homework consists of Maths and English, a weekly Spelling List and times tables practice. Additionally, children bring home a Guided Reading book; each week they are asked to read a set amount in preparation for their reading lesson. 3AN's reading lessons take place on Wednesdays, and 3GM/ZJ's are on Mondays. We ask that you support your child to find a time and place to complete this work. Please continue to hear your child read, if possible for 15 minutes a day. Thank you in advance for your support.

#### RE

This term, our Come & See topics are:

- Journeys: we will look the Christian family's journey with Jesus through the Church year.
- Listening & Sharing: we will learn about the importance of listening in our lives and the cost and joy of sharing;
- Giving: we will learn about how Lent and Holy Week are a time of giving in different ways and remembering the total giving of Jesus.

#### Maths

The following aspects of mathematics will be covered this term: addition & subtraction, multiplication & division, and money.

Within each unit, children will develop their Fluency, Reasoning and Problem Solving skills as we endeavour to deepen children's mathematical understanding.

# English

The main areas to be covered in English are as follows: diary entries, biographies and non-chronological reports. Please note that Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar are taught throughout each unit of work.

#### Science

Children will be learning about forces and magnets this half term. As part of the unit, they will learn about different magnetic materials and how magnets can attract and repel each other.

After Half Term, we will learn about plant and their life cycle.

## Topic

Our topic for the whole term will be Emperors and Empires, learn about the Ramans. We will learn about Julius



Caesar's attempted invasion, the power of the Roman Empire, the successful invasion by Emperor Claudius and the Romanisation of Britain. We will also learn about the British resistance to the invasion.

# Camputing

This half term, we will be learning about email safety and how to create emails. We will also learn how to use Microsoft PowerPoint. After half term, we will use spreadsheets and investigate online tools to create graphs to present information.

#### PE

Up until February half term Year 3's, PE will be on a Thursday and Friday. Your child will need to bring their PE kit to school on Thursdays.
