Curriculum Matters: Class Newsletters

Nut Free School

Since the beginning of this term, new pupils with severe nut allergies have joined our school. In response to this, we are now completely nut free due to these children's allergy being life threatening. The children suffer an allergic reaction (anaphylactic shock) through ingestion of nut products, cross contamination and by breathing nut dust in the air. It really is that serious. Therefore, we are asking for all members of our school community to help minimise the risk to these children by:



1) Avoiding giving your child/children nuts or products that contain nuts in packed lunches.

2) Avoiding giving your child/children nuts or nut products including cereal bars that contain nuts for breaktimes.

3) Avoiding items that contains nuts when supplying us with cakes, treats etc for birthday celebrations, sales or events.

Please note that where a member of staff notices a pupil eating a nut product, it will be removed politely and the member of staff will explain why this has been done. A message/call will then be made to the parent to explain why this has happened so they are fully informed and to remind them of the nut-free policy.

Thank you in advance for your efforts to protect these children.

Attendance

Overall attendance for the last academic year was 94.1%, which is below our Trust target of 97%. This year, we ask for your continued support as we work in partnership to ensure that school attendance is high. Please be reminded that the Department for Education states that:

- Parents and carers have a duty to ensure that their child attends regularly at school, where that child is a registered pupil at school and of a compulsory school age;
- If your child is unwell or unable to attend school for whatever reason, you must notify school;
- Schools have a responsibility to record attendance and follow up all absences;
- Schools may issue sanctions, including fixed penalty notices in line with the local authority's guidelines.

As stated in our <u>Pupil Attendance Policy</u>, leave of absence which has not been approved will be unauthorised and may lead to a referral being made to the Local Authority for action. For schools within Nottinghamshire County Council, a Penalty Notice will be requested if an unauthorised holiday is taken in excess of 3 days/6 sessions (over a 6 week rolling period).

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Liturgy of the Word/Mass

As you may be aware, Fr. Shalbin has left the Parish to take up a new role in Diocese of Northampton. The Bishop does not intend to replace Fr. This year, we will celebrate Mass for two in every three weeks; the other week will be a teacher-led Liturgy of the Word. Our first Liturgy of the Word will be celebrated with Year 6 in church on Tuesday 26th September at 9.30am. You're most welcome to join us.
