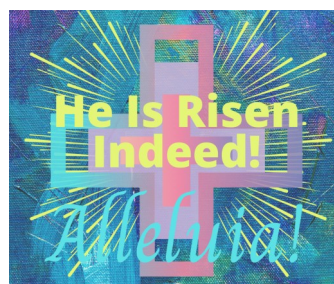

Coronation of Charles III and Camilla

As you know, the coronation of Charles III and his wife, Camilla, as king and queen of the United Kingdom and the other Commonwealth realms takes place on Saturday, 6 May 2023, at Westminster Abbey. We will mark this momentous event in school **on Friday 5th May** in a variety of ways. Firstly, it will be a **non-uniform day** where children are invited to attend school wearing red, white and/or blue clothing. We will celebrate with a special buffet-style lunch and in the afternoon, classes will be immersed in a range of activities from making nature crowns in the Foundation Stage, to learning more about the Royal Family tree and facts about the King and his wife, Camilla further up the school. Our celebrations will end with an assembly where learning can be shared. Further to this, each class will also plant a tree on the school field in memory of this occasion.

Please remember that **school will be closed on Monday 8th May** because of the additional Bank Holiday to celebrate the Coronation. **This is in addition to the traditional Early May Bank Holiday on Monday 1st May.**
