Pupil Attendance Policy

After the Half Term break, our current Attendance Policy will be replaced by a new Attendance Policy, which is to be implemented across all Our Lady of Lourdes Trust schools. If you would like to preview this new Policy before it is officially implemented, it can be viewed here on our website.

In the meantime, please be reminded that family holidays should not be taken during school time and will not be authorised. In line with Nottinghamshire County Council guidelines, a Penalty Notice (fine) can be issued if an unauthorised holiday is taken in excess of 3 days/6 sessions (over a 6-week rolling period).

Free School Meals

With costs continuing to rise, it's worth checking if you are eligible for Free School Meals. At present, every child receives a free school meal until the end of Year 2. However, children from Year 3 can also receive free school meals. To check if you're eligible and to apply, please <u>click here</u>. As always, our Office Team will help you if needed. For all parents with a child currently in Year 2, I'd strongly advise that you check to see if you are eligible ready for when they move to Year 3.



Arbor

There are still some families who haven't yet downloaded and set up our payment and communication App, Arbor.

The App can be used to make instant payments. You can also check key information, such as your child's attendance figures. And, if you move house or change phone number, this can easily be updated via the App.
