New Fencing Works — Update

I now have confirmation that the installation of our new fencing works **will begin next Wednesday**. This work has been partly funded by the DfE and our Trust to further improve the security of our school site. As you'll have read in previous Newsletters, this work will consist of:

- erecting 6ft green fencing along the perimeter of the school car park and installing new 6ft entry/exit gates;
- removing the wooden fencing that borders our Foundation Stage field and Tesco, and replacing this with 6ft green slatted fencing;
- removing the older green fencing at the end of our school field that borders with Westfield Lane and replacing with new, green slatted fencing.

The work begins next week with removing the Foundation Stage wooden fence and replacing this with the new green slatted fencing. The work will then continue after the Christmas break. We do not anticipate that this will cause too much disruption but once it begins, we will keep you updated if alternative plans or arrangements will be required. Thanks in advance for your cooperation.

Toddler Tales

Just a reminder that if you (or someone you know) has a child aged 18 months to 3 years old, we'd love you to join us for our Christmas session on **Wednesday 11th December @ 9:15am** where we will be sharing Christmas stories and having some festive fun. There will also be tea/coffee, juice and treats as usual plus a chance to meet and chat to other parents.

For those of you not already aware, Toddler Tales is a fun, interactive way to promote an early love of reading. The sessions also provide us with the opportunity to get to know the children who may be considering joining our Nursery at some point in the future.

Applying for a Reception place 24-25

If your child turns 5 between 1st September 2025 and 31 August 2026 and you require a school place for September 2025, you can now apply for their place. The application window will be open until the deadline of Monday 15th January 2025. Applications can be made quickly and easily through the Nottinghamshire County Council Admissions Hub. Please also remember to submit a Supplementary Information Form if you wish for a school place to be considered under a faith criterion. Please note that you MUST include the supporting evidence with this form. If you are unable to locate the required faith evidence, please contact the parish where your child was baptised in good time for a 'copy' certificate to be supplied. All the details and relevant forms can be found on the Admissions section of our website but please do contact the school office if you need any help or advice.
