
Many thanks to Miss Nicholls and to Mr Brown for enabling us to take part and thank you to the parents who were able to join us and cheer the children on.

Online Safety

The National College have produced some helpful guides for internet use, which are helpful for both children and adults. Over the next few weeks, I will share guides to provide you with more information about commonly used social media apps and games. This week's guide (which can be found on the final page of this Newsletter) is about WhatsApp, which is an instant messaging and voice-over-IP service owned by technology conglomerate Meta. It allows users to send text, voice messages and video messages, make voice and video calls, and share images, documents, user locations, and other content. The age restriction for WhatsApp is 13+.
