

Next week, our Word of the Week is **Pentecost**, which will form the basis of our acts of collective worship throughout the week. Pentecost is where we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit. At Pentecost the Holy Spirit came down upon the apostles in the form of tongues of fire, and they were filled with the Spirit and began to speak in other languages. This day is often referred to as the Church's birthday as it marks the moment when the disciples were inspired to go out into the world to share the good news, and to bring people to Christ.

Please be reminded that our school meals form part of a healthy and balanced diet and are freshly-prepared each day. A copy of this term's delicious menu can be found <u>here</u>. For children in FS2, Year 1 and Year 2, school meals are <u>completely free of charge</u>. For children in Year 3 to Year 6, the cost is £2.60 each day unless eligible for a free school meal through pupil premium funding. Find out if you're eligible by clicking <u>here</u>. The process is quick and easy too. All you need is your National Insurance Number or National Asylum Support Service Reference Number, your surname and your date of birth. If eligible, school will be able to support you in other ways, for example by heavily subsidising the cost of trips and visits, including residential visits.
