Applications to Reception Class

If you have a child attending our Nursery, please remember that your child WILL NOT automatically gain a place in main school; you <u>must</u> apply for a place.

Year 6 Parents — Secondary Applications

For parents of pupils in Year 6, the deadline is approaching to apply for your child's secondary school place. It is absolutely essential that all applications are made to your home Local Authority by the national closing date of Friday 31st October, 2025 or the Local Authority will assign a school of their choosing to your child. Notting-hamshire applications can be made here. Nottinghamshire County Council have produced this factsheet to make the process easier for you.

For the overwhelming majority of you who will be applying for a place at All Saints', please note that you must complete a **Supplementary Form** from All Saints' **as well as** the **Local Authority application form**. Information on admissions to All Saints' can be <u>found here</u>. It is important to note that if a late application is made, then this will not be considered until all other applications have been allocated; this means you may not be allocated a place in your preferred choice of school.

New Menu

After Half Term, our wonderful Kitchen Team will be serving up freshly-prepared dishes from our new menu, which can be found here. For children in FS2, Year 1 and Year 2, school meals are completely free of charge. For children in Year 3 to Year 6, the cost is £2.60 each day unless eligible for a free school meal through pupil premium funding. School meals can be paid for easily using your Arbor account.



It's always worth checking if you're eligible for pupil premium funding. The process is quick and easy and can all be done here. All you need is your National Insurance Number or National Asylum Support Service Reference Number, your surname and your date of birth. If eligible, school will be able to support you in other ways, for example by heavily subsidising the cost of trips and visits, including residential visits.


Woodleigh Care Home Visit
