Applications to Reception Class

For any parents wishing to apply for a Reception class place in our school next September, please be aware that the application window opened on Monday 3rd November and remains open until Thursday 15th January. For Nottinghamshire residents, applications can be made through the Nottinghamshire County Council Admissions Hub. If you have a child attending our Nursery, please remember that your child WILL NOT automatically gain a place in main school; you <u>must</u> apply for a place.

Please let us know if you have any problems or questions about applying for a school place. You will be notified on National Offer Day, **16 April 2026**, if your child has been given a place in our school.
